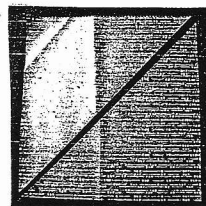
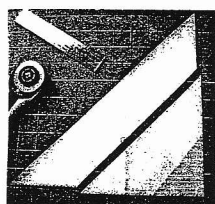


Charity Quilt 2017-2018
Directions
Seahawk colors, please.

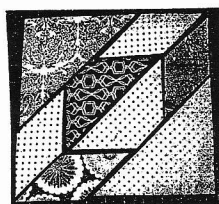
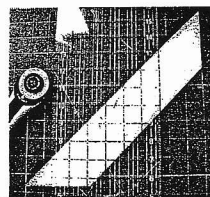
Thank you to the quilters in the JAQs group who showed me this technique.

You will start with a light gray colored 10" square and a Seahawk blue or green 10" square. Cut each square in half, diagonally.



Place the dark and light triangles on top of one another.
Place your ruler on the diagonal edge and cut a 2 1/2" strip.

Subcut this strip into diamonds as follows. Using the non-bias grain edge of your strip, measure in 2 1/2" and cut. Repeat once more, measuring in 2 1/2" from the cut you just made and cutting. (You should now have 2 dark and 2 light colored diamonds.)



Sew the block (1/4" seam), using the picture for color placement. These are bias edges and are stretchy. Let your sewing machine gently feed the fabric under the needle.

Please DO NOT trim the block.
