

2018 LOL Quilt Show Award Categories

A quilt/item can only be entered in one category. If you have any questions or have suggestions, please contact Pat McCrary at 360-241-6584.

Award Categories: Guild members will vote on Thursday, October 4th, for their favorite quilts/items by category. Winning ribbons will be placed on the quilts before opening on Friday. The public will vote on their favorite quilts/items by category on Friday and Saturday. Those awards will be placed on quilts Saturday afternoon.

Appliquéd (hand or machine) –Appliquéd and quilt top construction must be completed by quilt show entrant.

Traditional Pieced, Small (wall hanging less than bed size) – Wall hanging to sofa throw sized quilt top. Quilt top must be completed by quilt show entrant.

Traditional Pieced, Large (any bed-sized quilt) – Twin size all the way to king size! Quilt top must be completed by quilt show entrant.

Paper Pieced Quilts (all sizes) – May use any method of paper piecing to enter this category. Quilt top must be completed by quilt show entrant.

Machine Quilted (all sizes) – Quilt must be pieced and machine quilted (domestic or long arm) by the quilt show entrant.

Hand Quilted (all sizes) – Hand quilting is an art form unto itself. This category is for any size quilt that is created and hand quilted by the entrant.

Miniature (20”x20” or less) – Miniatures are tiny replicas of full sized quilts. (Think doll house sized bed quilts!) Must be entirely created by exhibitor.

Art Quilts/Original Art (all sizes) - Creations from your imagination! Size does not matter! Must be completed by quilt show entrant.

Dimensional Art (quilted craft items) - This could be a wall hanging with a 3-dimensional design standing out from the surface: a bowl, or anything that has three dimensions that is NOT wearable art. Must be completed by quilt show entrant. (3D = H, W, D)

Mixed Techniques – Paper pieced w/ applique, traditional pieced w/ applique, added embroidery embellishment, etc.

Wearable Art – Totes/Purses/Vests/Hats/ Jackets/ - Wearable art is any quilted or pieced clothing (blouse, vest, coat, jacket, etc.) or accessory item (purse, bag, hat, etc.). Must be completed by quilt show entrant.

Furniture – Examples include tuffets, furniture, foot stools, chair covers, etc.

Block of the Month – 2018 completed block of the month quilt or a previous year if not exhibited previously. Must be created and completed by quilt show entrant.

LOL Challenge Quilts – 2018 LOL Challenge quilts or a previous year if not exhibited previously. Must be created by quilt show entrant.

New Quilter (less than 5 years) – Any quilt style or method. Exhibitor is new to quilting.

First Time Entry in a Quilt Show – May be a new quilter or may be someone who has quilted for a number of years and this is their first time entering anything they have made.

Group Display – Projects completed by a group.

President’s Quilt – Must be pieced by LOL Guild members and completed by President.

Antique Quilts – Owned by Guild members may be displayed during the Bed Turning but **will not** be eligible for awards.

***Best of Show (all categories)** – Quilt that gets the most votes **over all** during the quilt show.
